a	How many students had a valid <u>medical exemption</u> to meningococcal conjugate vaccine? <i>Enter the number of students with a valid medical exemption to each of the vaccines listed. Students must submit either Form DHHS 3987 or DHHS 3995. The statement must explain the specific reason why each vaccine is detrimental to the student's health and the length of time the exemption will apply. A doctor's note or parent statement is not acceptable for a Medical Exemption.</i>	
b	How many students had a valid <u>religious exemption</u> to meningococcal conjugate vaccine? <i>A student may be exempt when the parent or guardian submits a written statement explaining that it is against their bona fide religious belief to have their child immunized. This statement must include the name and date of birth of the person for whom the exemption is being requested. These statements do not need to be notarized, signed by a religious leader, or prepared by an attorney. They need to be kept on file but do not need to be submitted to the state for review or approval.</i>	
c	How many students <u>had</u> obtained the required meningococcal conjugate vaccine? <i>Enter the number of students that <u>had</u> obtained (received) the required immunizations for school entry within 30 calendar days. <u>Do NOT</u> include students with a medical or <u>religious exemption</u>.</i>	
d	How many students <u>had not</u> obtained the required meningococcal conjugate vaccine? <i>Enter the number of students that had not obtained (received) the required immunizations for school entry within 30 calendar days. <u>This includes students with no immunization record on file as well as students missing documentation for one or more of the required vaccines.</u> Do NOT include students with a medical or religious exemption.</i>

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4	<p>Of the students reported in question 3d as not having a record on file or missing documentation of receiving the required immunizations for school entry, how many were not permitted to attend school (excluded) after the 30th calendar day from the first day of attendance?</p> <p><i>Enter the number of students who were not allowed to attend school (excluded) because they did not meet the state immunization requirements written in NCGS 130A-155</i></p>	
5	<p>Of the students reported in question 3d as not having a record on file or missing documentation of receiving the required immunizations for school entry, how many were given additional time in excess of 30 calendar days due to being in-process?</p> <p><i>This option should only be entered if the administration of vaccine in a series of doses given at medically approved intervals requires a period in excess of 30 calendar days, additional days upon certification by a physician stating that the standard series is in process, may be allowed to obtain the required immunization. Primarily applies to children on a catch-up schedule.</i></p>
